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Important Update

Health and Human Services (HSS) Announced Two (2) Additional Stimulus Funding Opportunities

As EMS | MC announced on Friday, Health and Human Services (HSS) announced two (2) additional stimulus funding opportunities available for ambulance providers. The second round of stimulus dollars is geared toward those providers with higher percentages of Medicare Advantage and Medicaid Patients.

While the funding opportunities remain the same, significant changes were made on Friday evening regarding how the second round of stimulus payments will be calculated. While early instructions indicated a reporting process of 2018 Net Patient Revenues, HHS has simplified the process to include a different calculation.

The portal to apply for the second round of stimulus payments is live, along with an application guide that will assist you in completing the application. Both can be found here:

In order to complete the application process, the following information is required:

- Must provide verification that you have already accepted Terms and Conditions for Round 1
 - Including access to the email account used for certification for security purposes
- Acknowledge that payments received are subject to public disclosure
- Must certify that the information submitted is accurate to the best of your knowledge
 - Misrepresentation or falsification of data may result in criminal and civil penalties
- Tax Identification Number
- Legal Business Name
- Bank Account Number
- Medicare or Medicaid ID
- Payment amount received under the Round 1 Stimulus Payment
- Type of Business – i.e. Corporation, Government, Non-Profit

- PDF Copy of your most recent Tax Return, 990 Form for Non-Profit, or most recent Audited Financial Statement for agencies without Tax Return or 990 Forms
- Estimate of Lost Revenue for March and April 2020
 - The [AAA](#) will publish a tool to assist you in calculating revenue impact
 - Keep in mind that this may not represent decreased receipts as most claims for March and April dates of service have not been fully adjudicated.
 - EMS | MC recommends utilizing a fully mature cash collected per trip (CPT) to be applied to the decrease in call volume for the months of March and April.
 - This may not be an exact calculation, You will be required to keep supporting documentation of how the estimate was calculated.

The entire process should take about 15-20 minutes to conduct. **This funding is on a first-come-first-serve basis and should be applied for as soon as possible.**

The calculation to determine the amount of funding received is as follows:

Total Gross Revenue {divided by} 2.5 Trillion {multiplied by} 50 Billion
Subtract the payment received from Round 1 Funding to determine the net
amount for Round 2

**If the calculated amount is less than the Round 1 payment,
there is no additional funding available for this round.**
